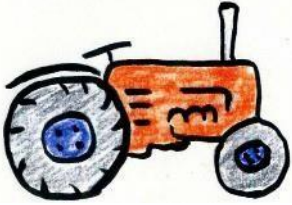

## Classic Cars & Lorries Entry Form

To be compliant with our Event Insurance and avoid potential injury to visitors and other exhibitors please adhere to the following rules:

- All vehicles can arrive from 7.30am and need to be parked and ready to exhibit by 9.30am on the day of the event.
- No vehicles are allowed to move after this time unless exhibiting in the arena. This will be at an allotted time and you must wait to be accompanied by an event marshal.
- **Movement is strictly prohibited** in the show grounds during the event. In the case of an emergency, you should contact a marshal or organiser who will assist you in leaving the grounds.
- Completed Application Forms to participate in TRACTORFEST 2019 must be received by 31st July 2019. Late entries may be considered in exceptional circumstances. Please be sure to provide an email address, as confirmation will be sent upon receipt of application.
- Where applicable exhibitors must be covered by the minimum insurance required by the Road Traffic Act with Public Liability Insurance for a minimum of Five Million (£5 million). Confirmation by declaration must be provided (See Entry Form). **All Exhibitors should ensure that Insurance documents are available for inspection at the event, should they be required.**
- Where applicable, Exhibitors must hold a current driving licence. Anyone under the age of 16, authorised by the owner, to drive a TRACTOR, must be under adult supervision and hold a driving licence applicable to the vehicle being driven.
- Access to the event site for classic entries, will be permitted from 9am on the Friday before the event.
- **On event days strictly no movement of vehicles will be permitted after 9.30am and before 5pm.**
- All vehicle movement within the grounds of the Event, when members of the public are present, must be under the supervision of a Marshall/Steward.
- Vehicles must be safely parked, braked and/or chocked in position and disabled when not being driven to and from the arena. No vehicles must be left running unattended. Drip trays must be provided if vehicle has oil leaks.
- Stationary Engines must be run for the majority of the time during the 'Open' period of the Event.
- Static Exhibits with moving parts below a height of 6ft must only be operated from behind a safety barrier.
- All entries should be presented in a clean condition.
- To gain entry Exhibitors will be issued with a vehicle pass prior to the event.
- Vehicles are restricted to a speed of 4mph on the event site.
- Exhibitors will be allocated an area for their exhibit on arrival. Camping will be permitted in designated areas only.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their children and pets. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and any mess cleaned up.
- You agree to adhere to any rules, instructions or safety measures imposed by the event organisers during or in connection with the event.
- The Tractorfest, its officers and representatives reserve the right to refuse entry to any person, business or organisation at their discretion.
- No balloons or sky lanterns permitted on site.
